Goal: Reinforce household livelihood after Hurricane Mathew

Objectives:

1. Enhance solidarity among community
2. Rebuild 8 house roofs

Direct beneficiaries: 8 households

Total Budget: 2,000 USD

Context:

Cyclone Mathieu violently hit the south coast of Haiti causing loss of life and considerable damage to vegetation, infrastructures and livestock. Many roofs of houses were swept away by winds leaving families without protection again sun and rains.

This project jointly led by HNGD and CCFEPS allowed 8 families in the locality of Beraud (Commune of Torbeck) to find a roof and to be quieter during the rainy season.

Each household receive a 222 USD voucher for a construction kit.

Kit contents: 30 toles, 4 wood 2X4X16, 8 slats 2X4, 7 pound nails.

People in the community contributed to the project by carrying out the repair work.
